**UNIVERSAL PRIMARY  
CONTESTS OCCUR WHEN ALL  
CANDIDATES FOR AN OFFICE  
HAVE THE SAME PARTY  
AFFILIATION AND THE WINNER  
WILL HAVE NO OPPOSITION IN  
THE GENERAL ELECTION, ALL  
QUALIFIED ELECTORS,  
REGARDLESS OF PARTY  
AFFILIATION,  
MAY VOTE IN THE PRIMARY  
ELECTIONS FOR THAT OFFICE.**

**FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE. THIS MEANS THAT VOTERS WHO ARE REGISTERED MEMBERS OF POLITICAL PARTIES MAY ONLY VOTE FOR RESPECTIVE MEMBERS OF THEIR POLITICAL PARTY IN A PRIMARY ELECTION. SOME EXCEPTIONS APPLY WITH NONPARTISAN RACES SUCH AS SCHOOL BOARD AND JUDICIAL RACES AS WELL AS UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTESTS.**

**UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTESTS OCCUR WHEN ALL CANDIDATES FOR AN OFFICE HAVE THE SAME PARTY AFFILIATION AND THE WINNER WILL HAVE NO OPPOSITION IN THE GENERAL ELECTION, ALL QUALIFIED ELECTORS, REGARDLESS OF PARTY AFFILIATION, MAY VOTE IN THE PRIMARY ELECTIONS FOR THAT OFFICE.**
